

PREFACE

This publication is in compliance with an act passed by the 1961 general session of the California Legislature, relating to the compilation and publication of election data.

The authorization is Chapter 133, Statutes of 1961, more particularly Section 6460, Elections Code, as amended by said chapter.

Statements of registration must be transmitted to the Secretary of State by the County Registrars of Voters and the County Clerks not later than the 135th day prior to each presidential and direct primary and also not later than the 35th day before each statewide election.

Apparently Section 6460 does not require the counties to report registrations under the "Declined to State" category relating to the various cities and districts. The counties did so report, for which this office is most appreciative. Without this grouping the figures would not represent true totals of registration credited to the cities and districts.

Also, the percentages appearing throughout this report were not required. Such information was added to lend assistance to those persons who might wish to study comparisons and as an aid in determining relative party strength.

The following persons deserve mention: Mr. Benjamin S. Hite, Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters, for rushing his voluminous report and offering valuable suggestions; Mr. Charles A. Barrett, Assistant Attorney General, for his expeditious opinion on behalf of Attorney General Stanley Mosk to clarify certain sections of the code; Dr. Eugene C. Lee, Acting Director, Bureau of Public Administration, University of California, Berkeley, for reporting on his registration research with ideas for classification of various registered groups; Mr. Neal Peirce, Senior Political Writer, Congressional Quarterly Service, Washington, D.C., for information resulting from his research on past or present existence of any "Non-partisan" or "Independent" political party; Mr. Ralph Titus, Assistant State Printer, for his design of the front cover.

In presenting this first report of its kind, I wish to express sincere appreciation to the above named persons and especially to all of the California County Clerks, Registrars of Voters and their deputies for their splendid cooperation.

It will be seen that the Statewide and County portions of this report show a DECLINE TO STATE total of 209,453 and a MISCELLANEOUS total of 4,897. By referring to the grand totals for the various cities and districts, the DECLINED TO STATE total appears as 192,339 and the MISCELLANEOUS total appears as 22,011.

The totals of the two groups, however, are the same throughout.

The difference, relatively unimportant, involves such types of registrations as "Non-partisan," "Independent," "Impartial," "Neutral," "Non-political," "Bipartisan" and "Unaffiliated."

It is believed these types more properly fall in the DECLINED TO STATE category for a report of this kind.

Wherever possible, such classification was made by transferring totals from the MISCELLANEOUS breakdowns. In some instances the MISCELLANEOUS breakdowns were not reported to the Secretary of State for cities and districts and therefore classification or transfer to the DECLINED TO STATE category could not be made.
