

PREFACE

This Report of Registration summarizes the number of voters, by party affiliation, in each Assembly, Senate and Congressional District located in whole or in part within each county, and in each supervisorial district and city located within each county. It reflects registration following the cancellation of affidavits of registration of those registrants who did not vote in the November 7, 1978, Gubernatorial Election *and* who *either* moved their residence outside the county where they were registered to vote *or* who moved within the county but failed to notify the clerk (in writing) of their new address.

Because the purge laws have changed, the number of non-voters in November *cannot* be determined by comparing these figures with the October 1978 Report of Registration figures. Non-voters have *not* been automatically removed from the rolls, as in years past. The above circumstances describe the criteria for cancellation of registration affidavits for the 1978 postgeneral election purge.

The purge of non-voters was conducted pursuant to Elections Code Section 706, and Elections Code Section 803.

This Report of Registration is prepared and issued under authority of Elections Code Section 610. The next scheduled Report of Registration will show the number of voters registered as of January 1, 1980 and will be published subsequently, pursuant to Elections Code Section 6460(a).
