

PREFACE

This is the fifth printing of registration reports authorized by Sections 458 and 6460, Elections Code.

The January report in even-numbered years is based on registrations of record with the County Clerks or Registrars of Voters as of December 31, usually certified to the Secretary of State by January 20.

Thus the report reflects political party strength at the beginning of the election year in the various counties, cities, supervisorial, assembly, senatorial and congressional districts. Also, the report would show whether a new political party has sufficient registrations to entitle it to participate in the elections and whether a qualified party may have lost such right due to lack of registration support.

It will be noted that the Prohibition Party has a statewide total of 3,847 registered voters. Unfortunately, this is below the 1/15th of 1 per cent of the state's total of 6,359,641 and under Section 6430, Elections Code, the party "is deemed to have been abandoned by the voters." Other than shown for the counties, the Prohibition registration figures are included in the "Miscellaneous" totals.

We have omitted the customary percentages. They will appear in the more important reports for the coming June and November elections, which will reflect substantial increases in registration covering the two major parties.
