## PREFACE

The Secretary of State compiles the "January" registration report in both odd- and even-numbered years, the report herewith being authorized by Section 458, Elections Code.

Registration affidavits of persons having failed to vote at the general election must be canceled by the County Clerks and Registrars of Voters not later than January 1. Statements transmitted to the Secretary of State in January of odd-numbered years purportedly show totals of records in the counties following the biennial "registration purge" and prior to restorations—the restoring to the files of registration affidavits of members of the armed forces and others entitled to restoration under Section 387, Elections Code.

Therefore, the January report in odd-numbered years not only sets forth a registration loss since the registration deadline for the November election, but has the purpose of giving a reasonably accurate approximation of *party turnout* at the November election.

For example, note that the "January" registration for Los Angeles County is 2,790,759. That county's total vote in November was 2,789,323, a difference of only 0.06 percent. Therefore, it is indicated that approximately 2,790,759 voters in that county went to the polls in November. This report shows that of said registration total the Democrats number 1,620,425 and the Republicans 1,077,749. It is thus established that these figures represent a reasonable approximation of party turnout at the November election.

The January registration figures theoretically differ from voter turnout only to the extent that in the normal processing of registration affidavits some affidavits have been added to or deleted from the rolls between the September registration deadline and prior to the restorations above mentioned.

To ascertain the approximate party turnout at the November 3, 1964, general election for the state, or in any city or district, merely refer to the January registration figures in this report.
