

PREFACE

This January report is the first of three registration reports scheduled for the 1966 election year. It is authorized by Section 6460, Elections Code, and has been compiled from statements received from county clerks and registrars of voters on or before January 23, 1966, based on their records as of January 4, 1966.

One purpose of the county statements is to make it possible for the Secretary of State to determine whether a new political party may have qualified for election participation resulting from the registration method. (The qualification deadline was also January 23 for the more difficult petition method, which has not been attempted since 1948). This year, as in 1964, California has only two legally qualified and recognized political parties—the Democratic and Republican.

Another purpose of the January report in even-numbered years is to set forth comparative registration figures or party strength at the beginning of the election year in the various counties, districts and cities.

Substantial increases will be reflected in the reports prior to the June and November elections. Being more important, they will carry an extensive use of percentages and probably some additional comparisons.

Note the substantial decreases in Napa County. The "post office change of address card" provision authorized by the 1963 Legislature is used, a system whereby registration affidavits of voters who move are either transferred to the proper precinct register or canceled. See Section 224, Elections Code, for details. As one of the few counties if not the only county using such system, Napa County probably has one of the "cleanest" record of registrations.

The Inyo County loss of 62 Republicans during the year is questionable in view of the 91 Democratic gain, although the county clerk advises the figures apparently are correct.
