

PREFACE

This off-election year "January" registration report has been compiled under authority of Section 458, Elections Code.

Cancellation of voter registration affidavits is made for several causes, most resulting in the "purge" of the rolls for failure of persons to vote at the last preceding general election.

The County Clerks and Registrars of Voters must cancel between the November vote canvass and January 1, reporting to the Secretary of State by on or around January 10. While some additions to or deletions from the rolls occur after the usual September registration close, it is the "purge" that mainly affects totals in a report of this kind.

Therefore, since the figures herein for the most part represent registration totals following the "purge" and before restorations it is apparent they reflect the approximate party turnout at the last November general election in the various counties, cities and districts. That is the primary purpose of the January registration report in odd-numbered years.
