PREFACE

This first report of registration for the 1978 Gubernatorial Election Year is prepared under authority of Sections 6430(b) and 6460(a), Elections Code, and represents voter registration throughout California as of January 3, 1978.

One purpose for this report is to determine which parties qualify to participate in the partisan primary elections on June 6, 1978. The results of the certified counts from the counties show that the American Independent, Democratic, Peace and Freedom, and Republican parties remain qualified. No new parties have qualified to participate in the primary election pursuant to Section 6430. In order to qualify by registration, a party must have 63,646 or more persons registered as affiliated with that party. There was no attempt to qualify a new political party by petition.

One additional table has been added to show the number of registered voters in each Equalization District.

This report has been reformatted so that the statistical information is presented in normal, vertical page format.

The next registration figures to be published will reflect the 54-day pre-primary totals as of April 13, 1978.
