

To Whom It May Concern:

The Statewide and County portions of this report show a DECLINED TO STATE total of 212,948 and a MISCELLANEOUS total of 2,954.

The grand totals of the various districts and cities show a DECLINED TO STATE figure of 196,037 and a MISCELLANEOUS figure of 19,865.

The difference involves such types of registrations as "Non-partisan," "Independent," "Impartial," "Neutral," "Non-political," "Bipartisan," "None" and "Unaffiliated," under MISCELLANEOUS.

It is believed these types more properly fall in the DECLINED TO STATE category, and were so transferred for the Statewide and County portions. Some counties did not provide the breakdown of miscellaneous registrations for the districts and cities—there being no requirement. Thus the difference.
