

PREFACE

Detailed reports relating to voter registration records are compiled periodically by the Secretary of State based on statements supplied by the county clerks and registrars of voters.

The reports are authorized by an act of the 1961 Legislature requiring a January report in odd-numbered years under Section 458, Elections Code, and three reports in election years under Section 6460, Elections Code.

This, the "June Primary" report, reflects party affiliation totals as of April 14, 1966, the date on which registration closed for the June 7, 1966, Direct Primary Election.

There is no statutory provision that the report set forth comparisons and percentages. This report contains considerable information in this respect and from comments received concerning such additional information in past reports we feel the added effort is worthwhile in lending increased value to the publication.
