Section 321, Elections Code, setting forth the Affidavit of Registration, provides that when a voter does not state a party affiliation the words "Declines to state" shall be written in or stamped on the affidavit.

The above "Miscellaneous" total of 22,106 includes 18,669 registrations such as "Bipartisan," "Impartial," "Independent," "Neutral," "Non Committed," "None," "Non-partisan," "Non-political," "No Special Party" and "Unaffiliated."

It is questionable whether a voter intends to affiliate with a minor political party or organization when registering under any of these designations. With the view that such voter thinks of himself as having no party affiliation by so declaring, the following table probably reflects a better computation:

The above "Miscellaneous" total of 3,437 covers registrations such as "Constitution," "Independent Progressive," "Progressive," "Royalist," "Socialist," "Socialist Labor" and "Townsend."

Note that the totals for the Cities, and the Congressional, Assembly and Supervisorial districts use the 22,106 figure for "Miscellaneous" instead of 3,437. The "Miscellaneous" breakdown, involving some 60 types or affiliation names, was not reported for each city and for each of such districts, there being no requirement.
