

PREFACE

Detailed reports covering registration data are issued periodically by the Secretary of State under authority of Sections 458 and 6460, Elections Code.

This is the seventh report and was compiled from statements transmitted by the county clerks and registrars of voters following the close of registration on September 10, 1964.

Although not required by law, the compilation contains considerable detailed information and percentages, believed advisable if not necessary due to the high degree of interest in the coming November 3, 1964, general election and because all past registration records have been broken.
