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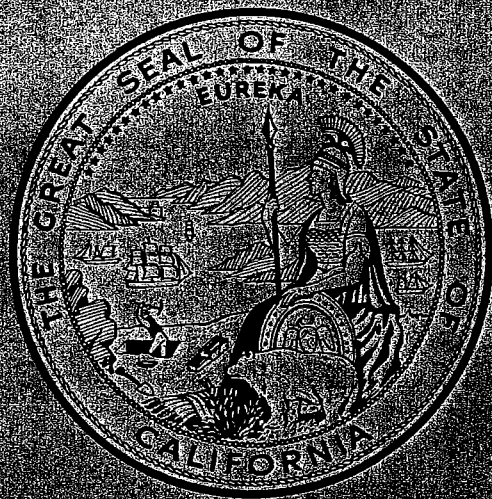

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PREFACE

This Report of Registration reflects registration figures as of October 9, 29 days before the November 7 General Election. Between September 14 (the 54-day pre-election report) and October 9, registration rolls increased by 539,336 registrants, largely due to several unconventional voter registration drives. Such diverse businesses and organizations as McDonald's Hamburgers, the National Guard, Granny Goose potato chips, Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Co., Beno's clothing stores, the Catholic churches, political parties and candidates, and numerous state departments and agencies and their field offices served as registration outlets and promoters. In this regard, county and state election officials were able to piggyback many voter registration efforts onto the marketing and distribution skills of private enterprises. The success of these drives is proven by the above-mentioned gain in registrations during the final weeks before the close of registration.

It should also be noted that these October 9 figures reflect a more accurate count of potential voters in California than ever before because of recently-conducted purges of the voter rolls. Due to urgency legislation adopted this year, most counties conducted purges between the Primary and General elections. Generally speaking, address correction requested mailings by county clerks and registrars triggered the up-dating of addresses or the removal of persons no longer living within the particular county from the voter rolls so that registration lists truly reflected the current status of registrants.

This October 9, 1978 Report of Registration is prepared under authority of California Elections Code Section 6460.
